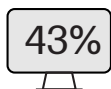

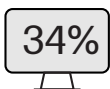

Remote desktop adoption rates for hybrid workers



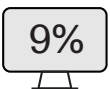
reported that over 50% of their staff actively use remote desktops.

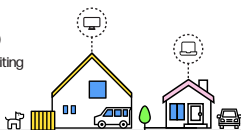
