EPEAT, the flagship program of the Green Electronics Council (GEC), is the leading type 1 ecolabel for IT products used by public and private sector purchasers in over 43 countries.

The EPEAT program provides independent verification of manufacturers' claims and is used by thousands of private and public institutional purchasers around the world as part of their sustainable procurement activities.

In 2019, GEC announced that the IEEE 1680.1 Standard for Computers and Displays has been updated and products that meet the standard's new criteria will begin to appear on the EPEAT Registry. This update represents even more competitive measures of social responsibility attributes which will prove to raise the industry standard around sustainability.
