# The North Pole

Lily and her Dad love the snow but the temperature must be below freezing to snow.

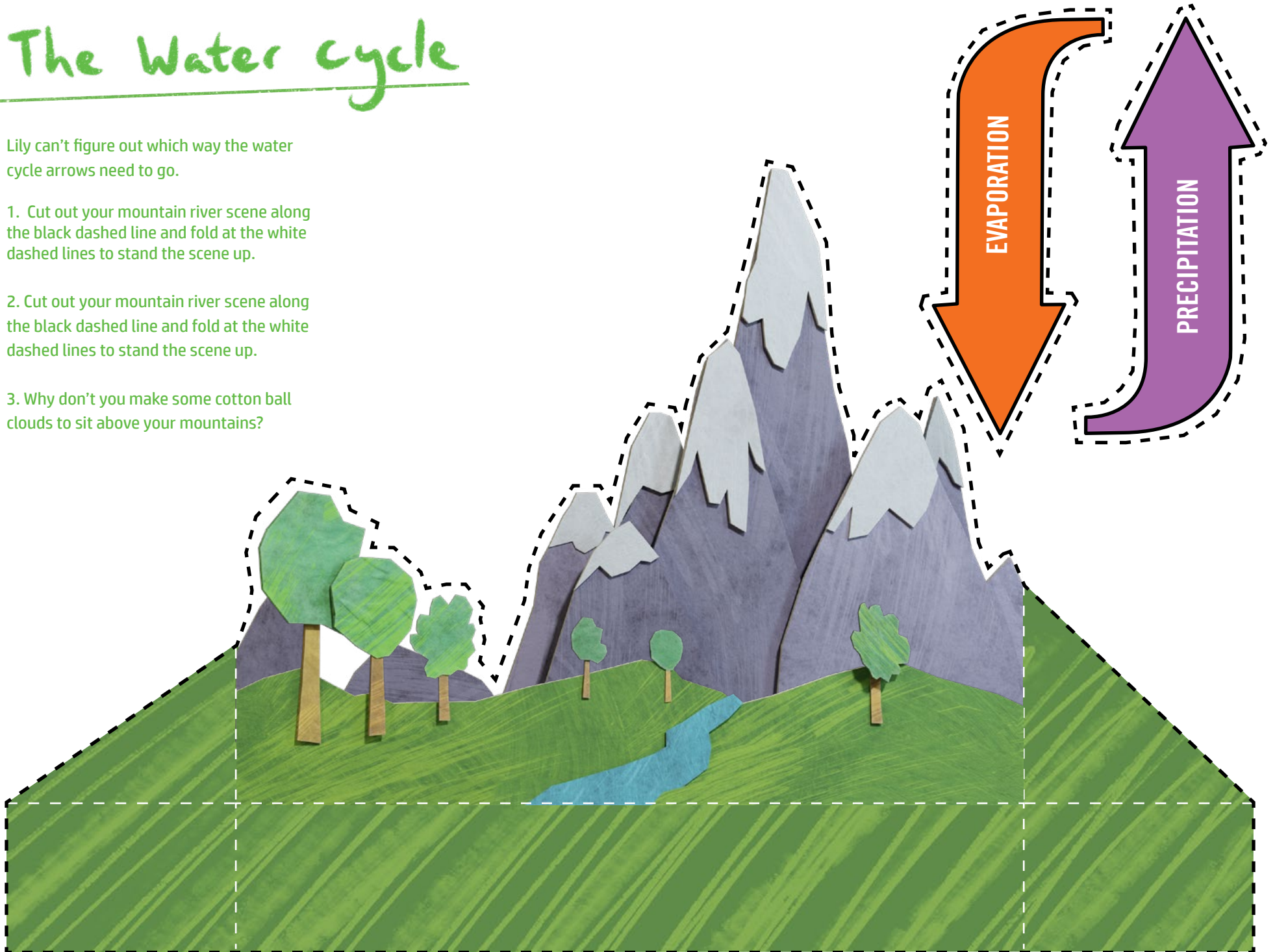
1. Color in the thermometer to the temperature of freezing.
